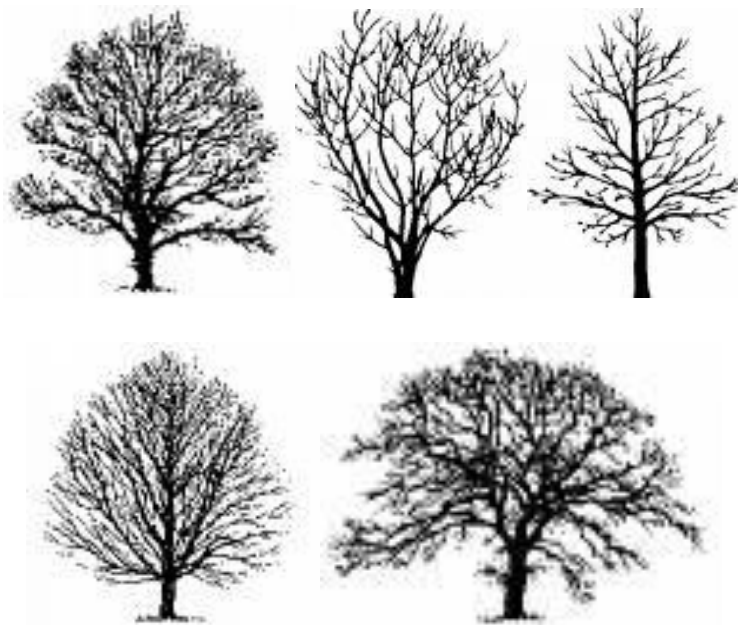



<p align="center">AA</p> 	<p>Royal Red Maple Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$80</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 40' / Spread: 35' / Shape: Oval to rounded Summer Foliage: Burgundy / Fall Foliage: Maroon/reddish bronze</p> <p>A great accent tree. Similar to Crimson King but faster growing (15-20"/year). Holds its colour all season. Soils: sand to clay. Withstands hot dry conditions better than sugar maples. Lives 60-80 years. Shallow wide root system. High wildlife value.</p>
<p align="center">BB</p> 	<p>Armstrong Red Maple Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$80</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 40' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Upright Summer Foliage: Vibrant red in spring, turning dark green Fall Foliage: Yellow to orange</p> <p>One of the best red maples. Transplants easily. Accepts very poor to good drainage. High wildlife value. Grows 12-20"/year. Lives 60-90 years.</p>
<p align="center">CC</p> 	<p>Red Sunset Maple Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$80</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 60' / Spread: 40' / Shape: Upright dense Summer Foliage: Dark green / Fall Foliage: Red and orange</p> <p>One of the best red maples. Vigorous tree with upright, dense growth habit. Strong symmetrical branching. Brilliant red-orange leaves last well into the fall. Soils: coarse sand to silty clay, very poor to well drained. Grows 12-20"/year. Lives 60-90 years. High wildlife value.</p>
<p align="center">DD</p> 	<p>Silver Cloud Maple Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$80</p>	<p>Zone: 2b / Height: 60' / Spread: 45' / Shape: Upright oval Summer Foliage: Light green, silver below / Fall Foliage: Yellow</p> <p>A very hardy native Silver Maple. Grows 2-3' / year. Good resistance to pests and disease. Soils: sandy loam to silty clay, poor to well-drained. Prefers moist soil but tolerates dry. Withstands temporary flooding. Matures at 60-75 years, lives 125 years. Very high wildlife value.</p>
<p align="center">EE</p> 	<p>Princess Diana Serviceberry Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.2" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$70</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 20' / Spread: 15' / Shape: Compact oval Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Brilliant red Flower: Creamy white clusters / Fruit: Purple</p> <p>Accepts a wide range of soils, grows well in full sun or partial shade. Fruit matures in July, picked clean by birds. Cold hardy, resistant to leaf spot.</p>
<p align="center">FF</p> 	<p>Madonna Crabapple Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$75</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 18' / Spread: 10' / Shape: Upright compact Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: Fragrant double white, opens early, outlasts most other crabapples. Fruit: Gold to red, size of a cherry.</p> <p>Soils: wide range, but prefers heavy loam, good drainage, full sun. Needs little pruning, but any pruning should be completed before early June. Good tree for smaller spaces.</p>
<p align="center">GG</p> 	<p>English Oak Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter</p> <p align="center">\$85</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 60' / Spread: 40' / Shape: Broad rounded Summer Foliage: Deep green / Fall Foliage: Yellow brown</p> <p>Majestic tree. Transplants easily. Fast growing, adapts well to many locations, very hardy, leaves remain through winter. Soils: sand to clay, moderately to well drained. Withstands some shade but not flooding. Prefers moist but tolerates dry soils. Grows 12"/year. Lives 200-300 years. Acorns attract birds, small animals and browsers.</p>

HH 	Greenspire Linden Larger tree, 3-4 years additional growth 1.4" diameter \$70	Zone: 3 / Height: 50' / Spread: 35' / Shape: Symmetrical pyramid Summer Foliage: Deep green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Excellent shade tree, small leaves, nice branching habit, rapid growing, retains its form as it grows. Soils: sand to clay, does well in difficult and/or moist conditions.
A 	Green Column Black Maple 6.5' - 7.5' tree \$55	Zone: 4 / Height: 50' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Upright oval Summer Foliage: Light green / Fall Foliage: Yellow to orange Native tree. Medium growth rate. Soils: prefers well-drained, moderately moist, slightly acid soil. Does not do well in tight, compact areas. Tolerates shade. Selected for its columnar shape and central leader. Good maple sap producer.
B 	Deborah Maple 8' - 9' branched whip \$45	Zone: 4 / Height: 45' / Spread: 40' / Shape: Rounded to oval Summer Foliage: Dark bronze green / Fall Foliage: Bronze A beautiful tree, with brilliant red new leaves turning dark bronze green as the summer progresses. Grows 12"/year, forming a straight central leader with evenly spaced branches. Soils: very wide range from sandy to silty loam. Prefers moderate to good drainage, but withstands drought. Fruit attracts birds and animals. Easy to transplant.
C 	Royal Red Maple 7.3' - 8.2' branched whip \$50	Zone: 4 / Height: 35' / Spread: 30' / Shape: Oval to rounded Summer Foliage: Burgundy / Fall Foliage: Maroon/reddish bronze A great accent tree. Similar to Crimson King but faster growing (15-20"/year). Holds its colour all season. Soils: sand to clay. Withstands hot dry conditions better than sugar maples. Lives 60-80 years. Shallow wide root system. High wildlife value.
D 	Columnar Sugar Maple 7.3' - 8.2' tree \$45	Zone: 4 / Height: 40' / Spread: 12' / Shape: Compact upright Summer Foliage: Dark green / Fall Foliage: Outstanding gold Grows 12-16"/year in its youth, forming a straight central leader well into its crown. Soils: prefers well-drained, moderately moist, fertile soil. Excellent narrow tree. Good maple sap producer.
E 	Flax Mill Majesty Sugar Maple 6.5' - 7.3' tree \$55	Zone: 4 / Height: 45' / Spread: 35' / Shape: Broad oval Summer Foliage: Dark green / Fall Foliage: Ruby red Cross between red and silver maple. Fast grower, free from frost crack and sun scald. Long-lasting fall colour. Soils: prefers well-drained, moderately moist, fertile soil. Does not do well in tight, compact or restricted conditions.
F 	Heritage River Birch 5.5' - 6.5' multi-stem tree \$50	Zone: 4 / Height: 40' / Spread: 35' / Shape: Broadly pyramidal Summer Foliage: Medium to dark green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Beautiful white bark, exfoliating as it matures. Resistant to Birch Borer. Soils: coarse sand to heavy clay, poor to moderate drainage; prefers wet to average moisture but survives dry summers. Grows 24"/year. Matures in 50 years. Good nesting tree. Catkins attract birds.
G 	Washington Hawthorn 5.5' - 6.5' tree \$55	Zone: 3 / Height: 35' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Broad oval Summer Foliage: Dark green / Fall Foliage: Orange scarlet Flower: white / Fruit: deep red in late fall, attracts birds Excellent specimen plant for the lawn or as a screen. Foliage bud is reddish purple, turning dark green when mature. White blossoms last 10 days. Easily transplanted. Soils: wide range, but should be well-drained.

<p>H</p> 	<p>Dolgo Crabapple 7.3' - 8.2' tree</p> <p>\$50</p>	<p>Zone: 3 / Height: 35' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Upright open Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White Glossy green foliage, white flowers and upright open habit. Well known for its bright red edible fruit. Used to make excellent crabapple jelly. Soils: quite adaptable, but prefers heavy loam, good drainage, full sun. Requires little pruning, but any pruning should be done before early June.</p>
<p>I</p> 	<p>Robinson Crabapple 7.3' - 8.2' tree</p> <p>\$50</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 25' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Upright spreading Summer Foliage: Bronze green / Fall Foliage: Coppery orange Flower: Deep pink Glossy green foliage, single deep pink flowers and bright red edible fruit. Used to make excellent crabapple jelly. Soils: quite adaptable, but prefers heavy loam, good drainage, full sun. Requires little pruning, but any pruning should be done before early June. Very disease resistant.</p>
<p>J</p> 	<p>Sugar Tyme Crabapple 7.3' - 8.2' tree</p> <p>\$50</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 20' / Spread: 17' / Shape: Upright spreading Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Bronze / Flower: Pink/white Glossy green foliage and pale pink buds that open to fragrant white flowers. Used to make excellent crabapple jelly. Soils: quite adaptable, but prefers heavy loam, good drainage, full sun. Requires little pruning, but any pruning should be done before early June.</p>
<p>K</p> 	<p>Swedish Columnar Aspen 6.5' - 8.2' tree</p> <p>\$45</p>	<p>Zone: 3 / Height: 40' / Spread: 7' / Shape: Columnar Summer Foliage: Shiny green/blue green / Fall Foliage: Yellow A vigorous grower, very hardy, with a narrow columnar growth habit. Excellent for lining driveways, property lines and privacy screening. Soils: coarse sand to silty clay, poor to good drainage, wet to average moisture. Grows 15-30"/year. Very intolerant of shade and prolonged flooding. High wildlife value.</p>
<p>L</p> 	<p>Redspire Pear 6.5' - 8.2' tree</p> <p>\$55</p>	<p>Zone: 5 / Height: 40' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Narrow oval crown, 4' clearance above ground Summer Foliage: Red/purple in spring, becoming glossy green / Flowers: masses of large pure white flowers in spring / Fall Foliage: Crimson purple Ornamental pear. Glossy dark foliage in summer, turning to a spectacular reddish purple in fall. Fast growing. Very adaptable to a wide range of soils. Tolerates dryness and pollution, prefers moisture and full sun. Lives 50 years.</p>
<p>M</p> 	<p>Crimson Spire Oak 4' - 5' tree</p> <p>\$65</p>	<p>Zone: 5 / Height: 45' / Spread: 15' / Shape: Very narrow columnar Summer Foliage: Blue green / Fall Foliage: Brilliant red Cross between English and White Oak. Soils: adaptable to a range of soils, from sand to clay, moderately to well drained. Prefers moist but will tolerate dryer soils. Slow growing, about 12"/year. Fewer acorns.</p>
<p>N</p> 	<p>Burenglish Oak 6.5' - 7.5' tree</p> <p>\$60</p>	<p>Zone: 4 / Height: 55' / Spread: 40' / Shape: Broad oval Summer Foliage: Deep glossy green / Fall Foliage: Yellow brown Cross between native Burr and English Oak. Fast-growing majestic tree. Soils: adaptable to a range of soils, prefers limestone soils. Lives well over 100 years. Acorns attract birds, small animals and browsers.</p>

O 	Red Oak 7.3' – 8.2' branched whip \$55	Zone: 3 / Height: 55' / Spread: 50' / Shape: Rounded Summer Foliage: Reddish, turning deep green / Fall Foliage: Red Soils: adaptable to a range of soils, from sand to clay, moderately to well drained. Prefer moist but will tolerate dryer soils. Can withstand some shade but not flooding. Slow growing, about 12"/year. Acorns attract birds, small animals and browsers.
P 	Curly Golden Weeping Willow 9' - 10' tree \$55	Zone: 4 / Height: 35' / Spread: 25' / Shape: Spreading, weeping Summer Foliage: Yellow green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Bright yellow branches year round, particularly in spring. Unusual twisted branches, curly leaves. Soils: coarse sand to fine clay, poor to average drainage, wet to moist soil. Very tolerant of flooding but not of shade. Grows up to 30"/year, requires lots of space. Very high wildlife value.
Q 	Ivory Silk Lilac 6.5' - 7.5' two-branched whip \$50	Zone: 2 / Height: 25' / Spread: 15' / Shape: Compact oval Summer Foliage: Dark blue green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Flower: Creamy white Outstanding ornamental tree with masses of fragrant, creamy white blossoms for 2-3 weeks in early July. Very hardy and cold-resistant. Soils: well-drained, fertile; can tolerate drought, blooms best in full sun. Grows 8"/year. Birds harvest seed in winter.
R 	Cortland Eating Apple 7.3' – 8.2' tree \$45	Zone: 3 / Height: 16' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Oval Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White Bright red apple, good keeper. White flesh resists browning when cut. Good for eating, cooking, cider. Ripens late September. Partially self-fertile. Soils: clay loam or clay, well-drained.
S 	Golden Delicious Eating Apple 7.3' - 8.2' tree \$45	Zone: 5 / Height: 15' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Oval Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White A great all-purpose apple (eating and cooking). Fruit is medium size, bright golden yellow, firm, crisp and juicy. Blooms mid-season, ripens early October. Self-fertile. Soils: well-drained clay loam or clay.
T 	McIntosh Eating Apple 7.3' - 8.2' tree \$45	Zone: 4 / Height: 17' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Rounded Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White Very popular, hardy variety, excellent flavour, crisp apple with attractive cherry red skin, greenish white flesh. Good for eating and cooking. Blooms mid-season, ripens late September. Soils: well-drained clay loam or clay. Partially self-fertile.
U 	Red Delicious Eating Apple 7.3' - 8.2' tree \$45	Zone: 5 / Height: 13' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Oval Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White Large fruit with red waxy skin, crisp, juicy, sweet, tangy flavour. Very hardy species, ripens mid-October, keeps well. Good for eating rather than cooking. Plant with Royal Gala or Golden Delicious for cross-pollination. Soils: well-drained clay loam or clay.
V 	Royal Gala Eating Apple 7.3' - 8.2' tree \$45	Zone: 5 / Height: 13' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Oval Summer Foliage: Medium green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White Medium-size apple with orange red stripes, crisp, juicy yellow flesh, sweet and aromatic, keeps 6 months. Used for eating rather than cooking. Does not bruise easily. Blooms mid-season, ripens mid-September. Requires pollination by another tree. Soils: well-drained clay loam or clay.

W 	Clapps Favourite Pear 6.5' - 7.5' tree \$45	Zone: 5 / Height: 13' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Compact round Summer Foliage: Dark green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: White Excellent fruit bearing. Smooth golden yellow skin, juicy white flesh with excellent flavour. Good for eating or canning. Disease resistant. Blooms mid-season, ripens early September. Requires another tree for pollination. Soils: well-drained clay loam or clay,
X 	Flowering Almond Cherry 5.5' – 6.5' grafted shrub, potted \$85	Zone: 5 / Height: 13' / Spread: 13' / Shape: Broad oval Summer Foliage: Green / Fall Foliage: Yellow / Flower: Double pink Double-flowered almond shrub grafted to a 4' tree stem. Covered with double pink flowers in spring. Soils: wide variety from sandy loam to clay, moderately to well-drained. Potted plant. Transplants very easily.
Y 	Eastern Redbud 4' – 5' shrub \$40	Zone: 5 / Height: 7' / Spread: 5' / Shape: Upright Summer Foliage: Blue green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Flower: Purplish pink Beautiful small clusters of pink pea-like blooms before leaves appear. Soils: coarse sandy loam to fine sandy and silty clays. Prefers moist but tolerates dry conditions. Full sun to shade. Transplants easily.
Z 	Charles Joly Lilac Shrub 4' – 5' shrub \$40	Zone: 3 / Height: 7' / Spread: 7' / Shape: Upright Summer Foliage: Bright green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Flower: Double, dark purplish red Flowers late May-early June. Soils: wide range from sand to fine clay, dry to moderately moist. Blooms best in full sun. Disease and deer resistant.
Z1 	Pride of Moscow Lilac Shrub 3.2' – 4' shrub \$35	Zone: 5 / Height: 8' / Spread: 7' / Shape: Upright Summer Foliage: Bright green / Fall Foliage: Yellow Flower: Double, pale pink, changing to white Soils: wide range from sand to fine clay, dry to moderately moist. Blooms best in full sun. Disease and deer resistant.
