



Westport Harbour

Welcome to Westport! We hope you enjoy your stay in our wonderful harbour and take advantage of all the facilities offered by Westport. The harbour is owned and operated by the Village of Westport. Docking and the use of all harbour facilities are at your own risk.

CHECK-OUT TIME: Check out time is 11:00 a.m. If you require additional time, please make arrangements with the Harbour Master.

FEES: Mooring fees are \$1.25 per foot and include power and water. Day docking fees for small boats are \$2.00. Seasonal passes are available for \$20.00. Day docking fees for cruisers of any size are \$5.00; if water and/or power are required, the charge is \$5.00 for each service.

PETS: Pets should be kept on a leash at all times, and boaters are asked to please pick up after their pet.

CAMPING: Boaters can camp without additional charge. A fee of \$5.00 per night is charged to non-boaters.

WASHROOMS: Washrooms and showers are located in the Visitors Welcome Centre and are open to the general public from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The showers are coin-operated and require either Loonies (\$1 coin) or Toonies (\$2 coin). One Loonie for 2 minutes or One Toonie for 4 minutes. Keys are available to boaters for access after regular hours; please return keys to Harbour Master before leaving.

LAUNDRY FACILITIES: A privately owned laundry is located at 33 Church Street.

INTERNET: The harbour is equipped with Wi-Fi. It is password protected. There is no charge to overnight dockers.

QUIET TIME: Is at 11:00 p.m., please respect other boaters and the community of Westport by adhering to this time.

RECYCLING: We will recycle your Canadian beer, wine and alcohol containers. Please leave them bagged or boxed in front of shed. At this time we are not equipped to recycle other items.

GARBAGE ACCESS: Access to a solid waste disposal bin at the Spring location is included as part of the overnight mooring services. Access keys are available from harbour staff.

SEASONAL BOATERS: Dock space is allocated by the Harbour Master, and each space is reserved. If seasonal boaters leave their space, the Harbour Master must be notified of the duration of their absence and of the approximated day and hour of their return. A specific site allocation on the harbour dock is not guaranteed if the site is vacated. The Harbour Master has the discretion and authority to allow other boaters to use these reserved spaces while they are not being used by the seasonal boaters.

TRANSIENT BOATERS: Space is allocated by harbour staff to transient boaters for the duration of occupancy and will be forfeited upon departure. A new space will be assigned if the boat returns.

LONG TERM AUTO PARKING: There is NO long term automobile parking available at the harbour site for either seasonal or transient boaters.
